[redacted] was interviewed over an extended period through May 2003 by FBI San Diego SA [redacted] and FBI San Francisco SA [redacted]. During those interviews, [redacted] admitted close associations and a family relationship with other terror suspects, but he denied personal involvement in terror activities. The FBI set leads to obtain evidence/information to corroborate or discredit [redacted]'s information and held off confrontational interviews until such time as lead results were returned. SAs [redacted] and [redacted] departed Guantanamo in late May 2003.
