Chaplains are first line on the spot closest to hostility to provide stress + trauma interacting sessions. Interact with soldiers and refer stress related to medical channels. Provide traditional counseling one on one or Chaplains conducting rounds of

Stress is treated as a battlefield product. Battlefield fatigue

Any Trends of detainees abuse and soldier counseling.

Can not quantify stress as related to detainees abuse. Chaplains are not transposing stress + counseling to detainees ops.

Most stress is family related not combat related. Soldiers tend to be more motivated in combat units.

Step loss / change in deployment dates are high stress producers.
